City of West Palm Beach CRA

“The ultimate objective of the CRA is to improve the economic health and quality of life in the redevelopment districts of West Palm Beach. The CRA is a quasi-public agency that operates under Florida State Statute 163 Part III. The agency has many powers at its disposal to spur redevelopment including the ability to acquire and sell property, provide incentives to attract private development remove blight and issue bonds to fund redevelopment activity.”

City of Quincy CRA

“The mission of the CRA is to redevelop areas that are considered blighted, deteriorated or otherwise in need to areas that are welcoming, cheerful, safe and economically vibrant.”

City of Tampa CRA

“The goals of the CRA are to eliminate the conditions of blight, adopt a comprehensive plan where all qualified residents & businesses are taken into consideration. Eliminate or reduce the negative impacts of traffic on the quality of life. Increase the supply of low and moderate income housing in the City, promote home ownership and correct deteriorating residential structures.”

City of Boynton Beach CRA

“The Boynton Beach CRA, established in 1982 under Chapter 163 of the Florida Statutes, serves to encourage diverse redevelopment activities, stimulate economic growth, create a destination core and enhance the visual appearance of the community by eliminating slums and blighted conditions, promoting crime reduction and providing for affordable housing within the City’s community redevelopment area.”

South Miami CRA

“The mission of the SMCRA is to prevent and eliminate the existence of slum and blighted conditions within the community. As a community-based initiative, SMCRA is structured with the basic intent of helping residents to help themselves. Through rebuilding, rehabilitation, conservation, and the redevelopment of these areas, the quality of life for all South Miami residents will be greatly enhanced. The primary vehicle for South Miami’s redevelopment effort, the South Miami Community Redevelopment Agency (SMCRA) is a dependent special district, created in direct response to the need for holistic neighborhood redevelopment and revitalization.”
