**RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY FOR THE 10TH AVENUE
NORTH GATEWAY PROJECT IN LAKE WORTH**

The Lake Worth Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) will be hosting a ribbon cutting ceremony for the 10th Avenue North Gateway project this Friday, December 11, 2009. The Gateway project was designed to provide residents, visitors and business owners with enhanced entranceways to the City of Lake Worth. The first phase of the Gateway’s project was completed on 6th Avenue South in 2007.

The project features new brick pavers, landscaped medians, new lighting features, pedestrian benches, neighborhood entry walls and a resurfaced roadway from I-95 to Dixie Highway. In addition, all overhead utilities were undergrounded and all existing water and sewer lines were upgraded in order to provide enhanced service to customers and to attract new development on the corridors.

The ribbon cutting ceremony will take place at 1:30 p.m. at the southwest corner of “E” Street and 10th Avenue North. Speeches from local officials will be followed by a lunch provided by Burkhardt Construction. The public and members of the media are invited to attend. Parking is available along all side streets; however, car-pooling is strongly suggested.
